Target students
The workshop is targeted for **University teachers and Researchers, Master’s degree students**, PhD students, and residency students, i.e., students who already hold a bachelor’s degree and will provide a comprehensive overview of current research in the emerging field of brain stimulation with focus on “non-invasive neurostimulation”. Lecturers are experts in these fields of research and in particular they will explore in detail different techniques such as:

- repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation (rTMS);
- transcranial direct current stimulation (tDCS);
- trigeminal nerve stimulation (TNS);
- transcutaneous vagus nerve stimulation (tvNS).

They will propose to the audience different applications and experimental models to elucidate the mechanisms of action and the clinical potentialities of these techniques. Will be highlighted the differences and/or similarities between the different techniques and their applications in research experimental models.
